The Westport Roanoke Community Center is nestled in an older historic neighborhood in Kansas City, Missouri. There is plenty of greenspace and parking, please be aware the road leading to the facility is angled on a hill and is brick cobblestone. The parking lots for the facility are paved, there is a driveway in front of the main entrance available for drop off, we ask that you not block that by parking there. Overnight parking in prohibited, but the parking lot is large enough to accommodate RVs. We will have a separate parking area and potty space available for reactive dogs. The facility is near KU Med Center, there are multiple options for lunch, but they are a short drive from the facility. You may prefer to bring a lunch with you, there is a small park across the street from the community center. Leashed dogs are welcome there.

The testing will be inside on wood floors at a community auditorium. There will be separate entry and exit doors to the testing area. If you will need a handicapped ramp for access please let us know in advance, the exit door for you will need to be changed.

Test Site Information

All dogs must be crated in your car until they are being tested, there is no inside crating available. You are responsible for picking up after your dog. All dogs must be on a 6' leash at all times when not being tested. No flexi-leashes for walking dogs on test site grounds; flexis may be used in the test itself.

The test site will be open at 9:00 a.m. Check-in begins at 8:30 a.m. Please do not arrive before 8:15 a.m. Handler Briefing will be at approximately 9:30 a.m. Detailed information about running times and briefings will be sent via email approximately one week before the ORT.

An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening date to be eligible for the first draw period.

Entry Requirements

The handler of the dog must be a current member of the NACSW[™]. The Dog must be registered with the NACSW[™]. For information on how to register or become a member go to www.NACSW.net

Score books are optional and are not required to participate in an ORT. They are for personal record keeping. If you have lost a scorebook or would like a replacement, you can request a replacement score book that will include all your prior NACSW results. Log in to your account at:http://www.nacsw.net and under the "My Account" section, go to "My Dogs" and choose the option to order a replacement score book there. The cost is \$20.

Entry Fee and Second Dog Policy

\$30.00 for first odor per dog \$30.00 for each subsequent odor test, two dogs per odor per handler limit. Separate registration form must be filled out for each dog odor/combination.

CHECK-IN/HANDLER BRIEFING

Details regarding check in time and briefing will be sent approximately 1 week before the ORT.

An ORT must be taken and passed at least 14 days before a trial opening September 22,2019 to be eligible for the first draw period.

NO SPECTATORS ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEARCH AREA during the ORT except NACSW™ officials, adults accompanying a minor, CNWI-in-training, or immediate family members/friends of the dog/handler team currently being tested.

ENTRIES:

- TELEPHONE, FAX, UNSIGNED ENTRIES, AND ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES cannot be accepted.
- RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks will inccur a \$30 processing fee
- ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ON THE ATTACHED ENTRY FORM or (Preferred) online at:

- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- OWNERS are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.
- EXPRESS MAIL entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- **DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs.
- The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged.
- Be prepared to keep your dog in your car when not being tested or on leash at all times.
- There is no inside crating at this test.

FEMALES IN SEASON – Contact your test host at least 1 day before the ORT if this becomes a possibility

DOGS PARTICIPATING in ORT must be at least six months of age and must appear to be healthy on trial day and should be current on all vaccinations required by law.

Acknowledgement of entry acceptance/CONFIRMATION will be made when entries are processed for those handlers that provide an email address. If you require a confirmation via USPS, you must provide a self-addressed stamped envelope with your entry.

BASIC DESCRIPTION OF TEST – to successfully pass an ORT a dog must identify the location of the target odor and the handler must correctly call an "alert" within a three-minute time period. The Odor Recognition Test consists of a drill type exercise which requires 12 closed boxes set up in a pattern of *one or* two rows, spaced a minimum of 48" apart. The ORT is conducted on leash. Complete information can be obtained on the NACSW™ website.
